



Bi-Election 2011 - 2012 Academic Year

Pursuant to **Article 6** of the **EP·S·A Constitution**, All UTSC students who are current members of EP·S·A, and enrolled in any undergraduate program offered by the Department of Physical and Environmental Sciences are eligible to run for any elected position on the Executive Committee. No Executive Member can run, apply for, nor hold more than one position at one time.

Applicants are required to submit their completed nomination forms in a sealed envelope to room SW520A (EP·S·A office) by Monday, October 31st, 2011 5:00 PM. Any forms handed after this time will not be accepted. On the front of the envelope please write in block letters the position on the Executive Committee for which you are applying.

Bi-Election will be held on Wednesday, November 2, 2011 at 5:00 PM in MW110

- Direct Communications (1)
- Volunteer Commissioner (1)

Candidates for the discipline representatives should be in the respective disciplines.

All candidates are required to familiarize themselves with the EP·S·A constitution and prepare a two-minute speech for the election. A question period will commence after the two-minute mark allowing the candidate to field any questions from the Executive Team and general audience.
