



Executive Interviewed Positions 2013 - 2014 Academic Year

Pursuant to **Article 6** of the **EP·S·A Constitution**, all UTSC students who are current members of EP·S·A, and enrolled in any undergraduate program offered by the Department of Physical and Environmental Sciences are eligible to run for the following interview position on the Executive Committee. No Executive Member can run, apply for, nor hold more than one position at one time.

Applicants are required to submit their completed application package along with their resume, in a sealed envelope to room SW520A (EP·S·A office) by Friday, March 22nd, 2013 at 12:00 PM. Any forms handed after this time will not be accepted. On the front of the envelope please write in block letters the position on the Executive Committee for which you are applying.

The application package should contain the two pages of the application form as well as a copy of the applicant's resume.

Qualified candidates will be contacted for an interview.

All applicants are required to familiarize themselves with the EP·S·A constitution and prepare for a 15-30 minute interview. The interview will be used to judge the applicants' qualifications for the position they have applied to.
