



Fall By-Elections Nomination 2021 – 2022 Academic Year

Pursuant to *Article 6* of the *EPSA Constitution*, all UTSC students who are current members of EPSA, and enrolled in any undergraduate program offered by the Department of Physical and Environmental Sciences are eligible to run for any elected position on the Executive Committee. No member can run, apply for, nor hold more than one position at one time.

Applicants are required to submit their completed nomination form and email it to vpmarketingcomm@myepsa.ca by Sunday, September 26th, 2021, at 11:59 PM. Any forms handed after this time will not be accepted. On the subject line state "**FYR Application:** " and the position on the Executive Committee for which you are applying. A complete nomination packages must include the following:

- Nomination Form (see page 2 of this document)
- CV or Resume

The tentative date for By-Elections will be held on Saturday, October 2nd, 2021. (Location & Time TBD). Any changes to this date will be communicated to applicants in a timely manner.
